

Health and Safety



When viewing the Severn Bore please be aware of the following:

- Water levels continue to rise for up to an hour after the bore wave has passed – the danger is particularly great near Stonebench
- Take care where you stand to watch the bore and where you park your vehicle – rising waters can cut you off
- Be aware of changing weather conditions – wear suitable clothing and footwear
- Don't walk out onto sandbanks – you may get stuck in quicksand
- Respect local property and animals
- Children should be supervised at all times
